End of class → Stay in your seat until dismissal by Mrs. P

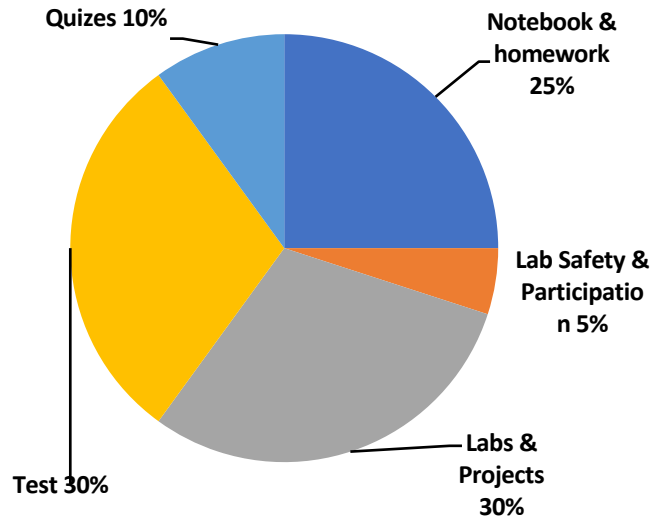
daily behavior

ABSENCES:

- Due to the material covered during the semester long course, **regular attendance is crucial** in mastering the subject content. It is the responsibility of the student to obtain the material missed during an absence. 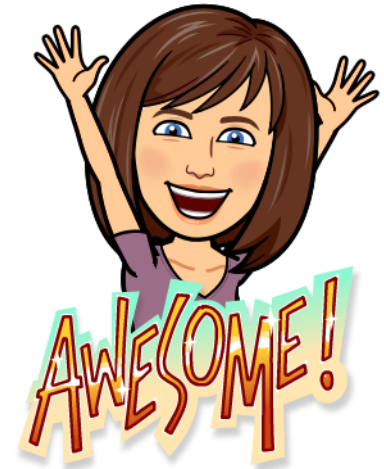
